TUFNOL Composites Ltd are pleased to announce that as part of the Diamorph Group's ongoing commitment to creating a truly world class manufacturing capability, we are creating three Global Centres of Excellence covering each area of our business. One of these three Global Centres of Excellence is our Composites and Polymer Materials Business Unit based in Gloucester UK.

As part of this integration, I wanted to give you advance notice that one part of the TUFNOL production process - impregnation of all grades of material - will re-locate to our Diamorph Gloucester site later this year.

The Gloucester site operates an integrated Quality Management System, which complies with the requirements of both ISO 9001:2015 and AS9100D and all TUFNOL products will retain the same design, materials, manufacturing methodologies and specifications.

Our world class machining facility, as well as production of sheeting, tubes and rod from sheet will remain at the Birmingham site. In preparation for the move, we have conducted extensive testing and capacity planning to ensure that our current high quality and production standards continue to be met when this process is transferred.

We are continuing to increase stock levels of all popular grades of TUFNOL material to ensure that supply is not disrupted during the transition. Purchasing of all TUFNOL products and your current customer service and sales contacts will remain unchanged. These services will continue to be based at the Birmingham site.

The Gloucester site will be at the centre of our multi-million-pound investment programme and will significantly enhance our manufacturing capability. It will also be the home to our Composite and Polymer Materials Innovations Centre, where we will conduct our research and development for composites and polymer materials, ensuring we stay at the forefront of advanced composite material technologies.
